About the Conference

The **ND Society for Range Management Annual Meeting** is a two-day event focused on the stewardship, management, and long-term sustainability of North Dakota's rangelands. The conference brings together land managers, producers, researchers, conservation professionals, agency staff, consultants, and students to exchange research, practical tools, and real-world solutions.

The program includes:

- Invited expert speakers
- Panel discussions and networking opportunities
- Coffee breaks each day
- Two lunches, one dinner, and a social event included with registration

- Student presentation competition (poster and oral)
